Changbai Mountain Biosphere Reserve

(N 42° 23'; E 128° 6')

Changbai Mountain is located in Jilin Province, northeastern China. The vegetation cover of the mountain range is characterized by temperate and boreal forests distributed in a series of well-defined zones. The area is also known for its richness in fungal diversity.
