


## Spiders of Rapa Nui





Rapa Nui is the most isolated island on the planet. It is located in the Southwest Pacific and has a sub-tropical climate. It is composed by 3 volcanoes (Maunga Terevaka, Poike and Rano Kau) with a highest elevation of 511 m. The island was the born place of a fascinating culture world known by the construction of the moais. In the same way, it has witnessed large environmental changes. Its aracno-fauna is composed mainly by introduced species from different parts of the world. Here, there is a sample of some of the species that can be seen more frequently.
